- Am I, as a parent, ready to support a teacher and my child in a non-traditional approach to learning?
- Is my child an independent worker?
- Is my child curious and interested in learning?
- Is my child able to appreciate the differences in others?
- Is my child able to accept responsibility?
- Does my child follow directions?
- Is my child able to focus on tasks for a period of time and not be preoccupied with things going on around her?
- Am I ready for my child to form a life bond with his teacher?
- Do I, as a parent, value independence in children and am I ready for my child to become independent and responsible for her own actions?
- Am I willing to be active in my child's education?
- Am I willing to support classroom management practices that encourage freedom within limits?



If you answered yes to the majority of these questions, your child may be a good candidate for an education at Washington Montessori Public Charter School.
