Zoom Meetings July, 14th at 10:00 am and 7:00 pm.

We understand that there were families who were not allowed in one of the two Zoom meetings we had on Tuesday. Below is the general information from the meetings. Please note that we are again in an environment in which things are changing extremely fast and while information is accurate when we disseminate it, it may change. We are working as hard as we can to ensure that we are able to provide a safe and stable environment for our students and families as we look to August.

Also, we will be sending out additional information via a letter that will be emailed to families and posted on our website and the Face Book Parent's Page.

Reopening plan:

Remote Learning:

- All students and families will have the option to choose remote learning if they feel it is in their family's best interest.
- Remote learning this year will be different than last year and will require accessing the lessons/materials at least daily, if not multiple times throughout the day.
- We will be taking attendance on remote learning.
- Remote learning will be graded for the Secondary program as regular assignments as though it were on-site instruction.
- The remote instruction will parallel what is occurring in the classrooms.

Operational Plans:

- Masks are required for all students K-12 as per the Governor's address. This is a change from the morning zoom meeting.
- K-6 will have class onsite Monday-Friday for those who wish to come back to the campus for school.
- The old middle school and the BASC room will be used as overflow space to ensure we are following DHHS social distancing requirements.
- Students will be moved to the "swing" spaces based on attendance in the classrooms.

- Students will still receive lessons from their “regular” guides.
- Music will not be offered in the music room next year or until the restrictions are lifted.
- Children’s House swing space will be the BASC room and LE and UE swing space will be the old middle school building.

#### BASC/Athletics

- We will not be offering a general Before School Program. (If there is an urgent need, we will have an application and process in place to accommodate families in need. Need is defined as employment that is not flexible enough to accommodate the educational needs of a family’s child(ren). Please contact us if you feel you must have before school care and do not have other options).
- After School will be housed in the gym. Spaces will be designated for the students.
- Athletics will hopefully resume shortly. Additional information and requirements will be sent to the coaches as soon as possible.

We will be setting up a Return to School plan with other frequently asked questions that will be posted on our website. Please stay tuned for additional information.

#### Jump Start:

- Students who qualified were sent invitations.
- The program may be opened to other students if space allows.
- The program will be held on *Monday through Thursday, August 3-6 and August 10-13* from 8:00 a.m. to 11:30 a.m.
- Focusing only on reading and math, Jump Start will provide intensive instruction/work in those two academic areas, breakfast for your student, and a ten minute snack break.
- No Before or After School Care will be provided.
- If you have medically fragile family members and are uncomfortable with your child physically attending the Jump Start program, you may choose a remote learning option for the two week program.
