DRIVER'S EDUCATION Process for WMPCS Students

- 1. You must be 14 1/2 years old to attend driver's education classes in NC. Do not sign up for classes if you are underage because you can be removed from the class the first day you attend.
- Go to <u>ncdrivingschool.com</u> to see what classes are offered. You may attend classes offered in your county of residence or in Beaufort County since that is where our school is seated. WMPCS does not host any driver's education classes on campus.
- 3. Once you finish the class including the driving portion, you will have fully completed the course. At that time, you will get a Certificate of Completion.
- 4. Bring the Certificate of Completion to Mrs. Carol Collier in the WMPCS office. It is a 48-hour turn around to receive it, verify grades meet the 70% passing rule for NC, and issue the form to take to the DMV to get the driving permit process started. The form issued by the school is good for 30 days. If it expires you will need to return to the school to see Mrs. Collier and get another approved form.
- 5. Driving is a privilege. If your grades fall below 70% passing your driving privilege can be revoked.
