Montessori "Going Out" Trips

Field Trips or "going out" is an integral part of the Montessori curriculum, which encourages students to explore and experience the world both close to and far from home. Dr. Montessori wrote: "The outing whose aim is neither purely that of personal hygiene nor that of a practical order, but which makes an experience life, will make the child conscious of realities ... When the child goes out, it is the world itself that offers itself to him. Let us take the child out to show him real things instead of making objects which represent ideas and closing them up in cupboards." Hence, the Montessori phrase of "going out" was born.

Children's House: 6-8 going out with at least 2 of those incorporating service learning within 30 mile radius. Planetarium, Southside Farms, Hope Farms, and local assisted living facilities are a few trips. Elementary: 2-4 field trips and service learning, which include The Refuge, Museums, Indian Pow Wow, and food pantry. 6th grade will have their first overnight trip in Spring. Secondary: Fall Unity camping trip, and in the Spring, they have a week-long trip. Secondary students have visited Nantahala, Washington D.C., New York City, and Williamsburg and have multiple service learning opportunities throughout the year. The Senior Class will also enjoy a senior overnight trip in the Spring. In the Secondary Program, students help with planning all their field trips.
