Local Heritage Project Field Trip

The 9th grade art class is doing a 3-part, local/heritage project where the students will choose a topic of interest to research. This project is a way for the 9th graders to look at their local culture and place. The 3-part, local heritage project will contain a self portrait, a short research paper, and a painted paver (for the pathway we are creating). The whole process began with the prompt for the class to create a legacy project- and they decided to create a pathway to the classroom. The project will also encompass several outings within the community- 1) to view and discuss an installation of watercolors (with a similar theme) on the campus of BCCC; 2) to go river roving and to the estuarium; and 3) if time allows, to visit Goose Creek State Park. They are realizing how special the culture, economy, people, food, nature, history, etc. is where they live. Stay tuned for a follow up story on the Heritage Project.
