International Day of Peace

Washington Montessori students celebrated International Day of Peace on Thursday. The school joined Montessori schools from 65 countries to sing "Light a Candle," the international Montessori song of peace. The school emphasizes a peace curriculum through direct instruction on manners and social graces. These "Grace and Courtesy" lessons begin in Children's House with 3-year-olds and sustain all the way through high school. At the core of these lessons is respect for others, self and the environment. Students also utilize a "peace table" for conflict resolution. Dr. Maria Montessori, the founder of the Montessori philosophy, who was nominated for the Nobel Peace Prize in 1949, 1950, and 1951, said, "Peace is what every human being is craving for, and it can be brought about by humanity through the child."

The International Day of Peace was established in 1981 by the United Nations General Assembly. In 2001, the General Assembly unanimously voted to designate the day as a period of non-violence and cease-fire.

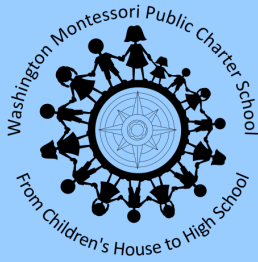


Staff Spotlight
